Application Guidelines

1. Only amateur sports organizations are eligible.
2. Events must utilize services/facilities within the City of Kamloops.
3. When multiple championships are held in the same sport and on the same date, the event will be considered on an individual basis.
4. Provided funds are available, the maximum amount allocated will be:

Regional Tournament*	participants from throughout the Interior	\$ 200
Provincial Tournament	participants from throughout BC	\$ 500
Western Canadian Tournament	participants from throughout BC, AB, SK, and MB	\$1,000
National Tournament	participants from throughout Canada	\$1,500
Invitational Tournament**	participants from out of town	\$1,500

*Regional Tournaments must consist of a minimum of four out of town teams and a minimum of 50 participants.

**Invitational Tournaments must consist of a minimum 50 participants (maximum 750) from out of town. Grant is based on \$2 per person.

Please Note

- Applications must include a letter from the governing sport body confirming the event as a bona fide championship whenever applicable (excluding Fourth Day Free, Invitational Tournaments, and Regional Tournaments).
- All applications deemed to be eligible will be reviewed by the Tournament Capital Grant Committee for its recommendation.
- Grant applications will be reviewed and approved for payment on an ongoing basis. **Applicants should apply a minimum of three months prior to event date.**
- Any additional information that you feel will assist the Tournament Capital Grant Committee in the evaluation of your application may be attached.
